GBNC is currently finalising member application and will soon recruit and appoint an Administrative Assistant for 3 days per week for up to 1 year.


This role will champion inputting information about services in and to the Granite Belt AND ongoing encourage community groups and members to put their event or activity on the community diary.

New program commencing soon – Healthy Ageing Support

GBNC was approached by the Darling Downs & West Moreton Primary Health Network with regards to a one-year demonstration project - Healthy Ageing Support.

Contract negotiations are well advanced with funding due to be granted early July 2023 for 1 year until 30th June 2024.

Update on Southern Downs Suicide Prevention Network

Its official!



Southern Downs Suicide Prevention Network is up and running, with the launch occurring over 2 days April 8th in Warwick & April 23rd in Stanthorpe.

Both days were tied to marketing days within the town and were very well supported by locals. Wesley Mission staff who were involved in the setup of the Network were also in attendance to lend their support to members and talk to people about the new network.



A raffle that was held over the course of the launch was hugely popular with 29 prizes and several hundred dollars raised.

Wesley Mission recently provided free suicide prevention training to the community in both Stanthorpe & Warwick these were both well attended, giving attendees skills in identifying and communicating with people who may be at risk of suicide.

Looking forward, SDSPN has booked a guest speaker Stuart O'Neill author of 'Just ONE reason' a very powerful book helping to open up a dialogue about suicide. With generous funding from HealthWise and GBNC, Stuart is booked to speak on Wednesday 26th July in Stanthorpe & Warwick.

Meetings are now on 3rd Monday of the month at 5.30pm meeting at SDIEA in Warwick and RSL in Stanthorpe with a combined Zoom link.

Social Value of GBNC – 2022 Report Snapshot

Annually, the peak body for Neighbourhood Centres in Qld conducts a survey to establish the social value arising from neighbourhood centres. GBNC's report indicates it:

- Provided \$831,307 in community value in 2022
- Improved quality of life through social connection valued at \$222.847
- Valued volunteers' time contribution to \$67,140
- Valued community to \$6.72 for every \$1 of Qld Government funding for neighbourhood centres.

Early Years

Activities for parents and their children (prenatal to 8 years) for example, weekly Lego therapy and two Playgroups (Tuesdays and Thursdays).

Youth

Activities aimed at working with youth who are at risk of disengaging from school, family and/or the community.

Mental Wellbeing (PHN)

Focuses on initiatives to improve individual and community response to mental health needs of any aged residents.

Family Support Services

Assists vulnerable families to develop family/household management skills, improve life skills and provide information, advice and referral. During school terms Baby & Me runs for 5 weeks and is aimed at new parents.

Emergency Relief

Available to assist on a time-limited basis with basic life needs and is available to any person/resident in the area including backpackers

Community Support Services

Assists vulnerable individuals in an integrated way by increasing life skills, connecting people to the community, events, projects and resources to benefit the whole community.

Kids Korner

Limited hours childcare for children aged 15 months to 5 years. Days of operation are Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Casual use is encouraged.

Driving Work Life Opportunities

Aims to expand life options & employment through addressing the barriers that prevent persons aged 16-25 years from obtaining a drivers licence. This program works with the PCYC's Braking the Cycle Stanthorpe program.

Sustaining Tenancies

Available through GBNC for clients with tenancy-related issues. A realistic payment plan will be set up to come out of your Centrelink payments

Foodsupport

Available weekly on a Thursday morning via a referral from GBNC staff. Clients are to attend our Food Support at 15 Hilton St 8.45am-9.45am only.
