Local blacksmith **Adrian Hobba** is returning to SRAG with his metalwork pieces (**The Sculptural Point**) alongside local photographer (and Borderline member) **Keith Barnett** who is presenting images of his recent travels around Australia (**Just a Second**). Also, **Heather Cohen**, a Glen Innes artist is showing large scale images of musical sessions and concerts (**Raw Jam**). Exhibiting in the upper space are wildlife artists **Kathleen Davis** and **Margaret Hodgson** who are displaying a collection of photographs and sketches of rare flora and fauna (**The Green Canvas**).

Art from Nature (from material provided by the artists)

The Green Canvas is an eclectic exhibition of artworks in several mediums presented by natural history artists Kathleen Davies and Margaret Hodgson OAM.

The collection of works brings to light the beauty and intricate detail of the natural world around us through the eyes and hands of these two artists.

Some of the images were developed several decades ago and have been reproduced in interpretive projects by government departments and community agencies. The majority, however, were produced in recent years and display a wealth of variety in technique and subject matter by both Kathleen and Margaret. Their lives have travelled in parallel, finally meeting at the same crossroads and merging their talents in combined events such as *The Green Canvas* to further the conservation cause and focus attention on the art of science.

Kathleen (a former manager of the SRAG) will also be exhibiting from September 24 for two

weeks at **Pyramids Road Wines** near Girraween.

There is an **open art group** that meet at the Gallery on the first Wednesday of every month.

Six months ago a team of around a dozen people met to plan and design their yarn bombed kitchen, planned to be the drawcard event for the Jumpers and Jazz in July festival. By the time Knitchen was installed over fifty people had helped out with the furniture (both handbuilt and donated), knitting, crocheting, sewing, wrapping, embroidering, weaving, felting and painting.

Although not listed, many of the parents and grandparents are also represented in this artwork in the form of beautiful vintage lace items donated by team members.
